Category:Electronic design automation softwareJuvenile dermatomyositis presenting with palmar myositis. A 7-year-old female presented with a history of weakness and joint pain in the small joints of the hands and feet. The patient had no history of acute skin rash or oral ulcers. Physical examination revealed severe muscle weakness in the small joints of both hands with only mild muscle strength in the large muscle groups and increased muscle bulk. Palmar myositis was detected by physical examination of the patient's hands. Laboratory studies were unremarkable. A muscle biopsy specimen from the proximal anterior tibial muscle showed a well-circumscribed inflammatory lesion consisting of chronic inflammatory cells. This result was compatible with palmar myositis of the hands. Magnetic resonance imaging revealed extensive inflammatory activity in the medial thigh muscles. Although the initial diagnosis was juvenile dermatomyositis, myositis was subsequently confirmed by muscle biopsy, showing muscle inflammation.Alex Ferguson Jr. Alex Ferguson Jr. (born 12 January 1983) is a Scottish former rugby union and professional rugby league footballer who played in the 2000s and 2010s. He left London Wasps and joined Super League side Castleford Tigers at the end of the 2008 season. Alex returned to his hometown club of St Helens after signing for the Saints in May 2010 and scored on his return in a 32–8 defeat by Wigan Warriors on 21 August 2010. He then featured in the 2010 Super League Grand Final defeat by the Wigan Warriors f678ea9f9e
